He(she) will carry out research in the molecular genetic area with emphasis on psychiatry and mental health and additions of the highest quality. In charge of cloning, sequencing, genotyping, mutation and expressing proteins of interest to the research carried out.

Cell Biologist / Pharmacologist. Will conduct research in all areas of research of the Neurophysiology Laboratory. In charge of characterizing effects and mechanisms of action of active biomolecules in the nervous system.

It is expected that both postdocs will develop a rich level of collaborations, including the application for additional extramural funding.

The position is for three years. It is best suited for proactive, goal-oriented, recently graduated Ph.D.s with experience in two or more techniques previously mentioned. The selected applicants are expected to be able to work in a collaborative manner and be productive publishing results in ISI Journals.
